




<u>Domenico Orefice</u> presented Man de Milan (Hands of Milan) — a collection of objects created with local artisans that explore materials, history and the icons that belong to Milan's identity. When combined, the Curti collection of modular clay tiles creates an image of the city. His textile collection depicts the facades of some of the most recognizable Milanese buildings around Sant' Ambrogio, designed by prolific Milanese architects like Giovanni Muzio and Gio Ponti.
